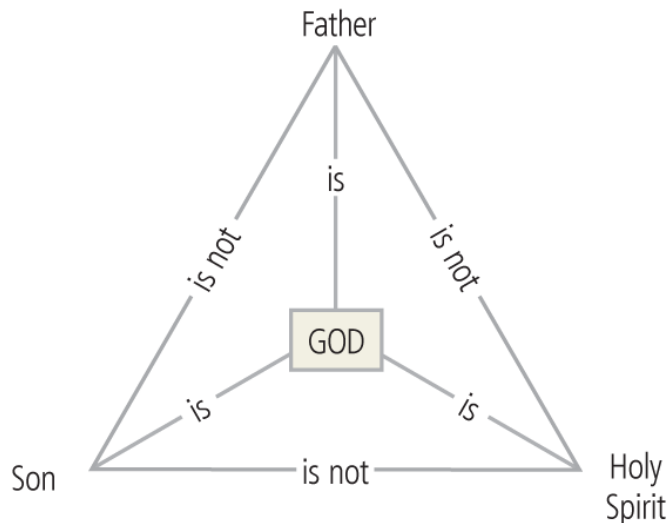


### Who is the Holy Spirit?

- The Holy Spirit is \_\_\_\_\_ God (Acts 5:3-4; Romans 8:9; 1 Peter 4:14)
- The Holy Spirit exhibits the \_\_\_\_\_ of God such as eternity (Hebrews 9:14), omnipresence (Psalm 139:7-10), omniscience (1 Corinthians 2:10), and omnipotence (Luke 1:35-37; Job 33:4)

- Indwelling some people (Numbers 11:24-29) temporarily (Judges 6:34; 1 Samuel 16:12-14) for specific tasks (Judges 6:34, 14:6; Exodus 31:2-4)

- Providing guidance (Romans 8:14; Galatians 5:16)
- Interceding (Romans 8:26)

- Sealing (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- Producing fruit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Equipping with gifts (1 Corinthians 12; Romans 12:6-8; Ephesians 4:11-13; 1 Peter 4:10-11)

### What are Spiritual gifts?

A spiritual gift is a God-given ability for spiritual service
